A Fruitful Ministry

We are becoming a rarity among ministries, one which puts all your resources to work in calling people out of their spiritual "lost-ness": nearly 30,000 people heard that message through our evangelists just this past year; over two million in our thirty-four years of ministry. This has resulted in the re-routing of the lives for eternity of more than 70,000 people (that we have knowledge of).

To be very specific and current, just this past month more than fifty people in Waconia, Minnetonka, Fridley, Buffalo, Mendota Heights, and at the University of Minnesota (all in MN); St. Croix Falls (in WI); Sioux Falls (in SD); and in other locations, were born-again and are heaven bound as a result of the events of our evangelists. That doesn't even count the international impact!

A Compassionate Ministry

Jesus was motivated by compassion when He saw His lost "sheep." The primary avenue for future survival of *FaithSearch* is the shared conviction in the hearts of evangelical Christians that Jesus' lost sheep are His highest priority; that *FaithSearch* is exceptional in our mission to help fulfill that priority; and that they thus

place us high on their charitable priority list. If we evangelical Christians who understand the spiritual lostness of humankind do not give compassionately and sacrificially to ministries like FaithSearch which effectively reach them, who will?

My wife, Vernee, and I devote most of our charitable giving to evangelism ministries—those whose priority is to proclaim the salvation message of Jesus—not because the many compassion ministries are not worthy or biblical, but because their appeal to such heart-wrenching felt needs in our world today (hurricanes, terrorism acts,

orphans, famine, tsunamis, etc.) draw in so many to their cause that there are few of us left who will give to an even more heart-wrenching cause: the millions of men, women, and children who are destined for an eternity of separation from God—unless someone intervenes!

Jesus' words quoted above about His passion for the harvest (Matthew 9:37-38) are followed in chapter 10 by an astounding statement:

"He who receives a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward; and he who receives a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward. And whoever in the name of a disciple gives to one of these little ones even a cup of cold water to drink, truly I say to you he shall not lose his reward" (Matthew 10:41-42).
